- ➤ Storm Drain & Catch basin: 8 Days worked on catch basins & storm drains:
- ➤ Vac Truck: Jetting storm drain lines for: 2 days.
- > Sign Work: 10 Days, replaced, and, or repaired street signs.
- ➤ Bushhog, cutback sidelines: 14 Days bushhogging cutting back throughout city
- Camera Van: 2 Days used Camera Van to clean drains & catch basins.
- > Street Sweeper: 9 Days of sweeping city streets.
- > Street Work: 20 Days of patching potholes and sidewalks.
- > Grass Cutting: 10 Days of cutting grass in the city.
 - 1. Cut grass twice in May for Mother's Day and Memorial Day. 2 employees, and 4 Labor Finders.
 - 2. Poured concrete pads at OC Building for driveway.
 - 3. Public Services replaced section of storm drain line on Jackson Street and West Arlington. We also built a new blind box, and new catch basin, due to large sink hole in the road.
 - 4. Cleaned downtown and setup for Family Fest, also set up barricades etc. Public Services worked Family Fest, then stayed, to cleaned up after it was over.
